Subject: Renewal of permission for 2<sup>nd</sup> year BDS course **with reduced seats from 100 to 50** seats at R.R. Dental College & Hospital, Udaipur for the academic session 2014-15 - reg.

Sir,

1 I am directed to say that Dental Council of India vide letter No. DE-3(308)-2014/A-911 dated 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2014 has recommended to the Central Government to renew the permission for 2<sup>nd</sup> year BDS course **with reduced seats from 100 to 50** seats at R.R. Dental College & Hospital, Udaipur for the academic session 2014-15 due to certain deficiencies referred therein.

2 Further, in terms of provisions contained in Section 10 A (4) of Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993, an opportunity of hearing was given to you in the Ministry on 30.6.2014 by a Committee constituted for the purpose. After considering the submission made by you/your representative, the said Committee recommended to the Central Government to refer the case to DCI for review & conduct of compliance verification assessment. Accordingly the compliance report submitted by the college was forwarded to DCI vide letter No. V. 12017/5/2010-DE dated 2.07.2014.

3 In response to the above, DCI vide its letter dated 8.07.2014 (copy enclosed) informed that the Council cannot consider / re-consider any compliance report / representation / application of a dental college without physical verification / compliance verification inspection and the Council as per statutory time Schedule and directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Priya Gupta case and Mridul Dhar case cannot carry out any fresh inspection after 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2014 for the present year 2014-15. Finally, The Executive Committee of DCI reiterated its earlier decision for permission for reduced intake.


4 Keeping in view of the above, the Central Government has accepted the above recommendations of DCI and now hereby conveys its approval for renewal of the permission for 2<sup>nd</sup> year BDS course **with reduced seats from 100 to 50** seats at R.R. Dental College & Hospital, Udaipur for the academic session 2014-15.

5 This permission with reduced intake from 100 to 50 seats is valid for one year and for admitting **only one batch of 50 students during the academic session 2014-15**. The next batch of students in BDS course will be admitted in the college only after renewal of Central Government permission.

6 The admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action under section 10 B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 will be initiated.

7 Discrepancies, if any, may be brought to the Notice of DCI and State / Central Government.
